FSA The FSA Awards Ceremony is the culmination of Wednesday's programme. The uniqueness of the competition is in rewarding fairness and social responsibility in the e-enabling of procurement processes in both the public and private sectors. The competition has three categories: START, TREND and MASTER. This year is the fifth annual FSA. It is organised by the Czech and Slovak Associations of Providers and Users of Electronic Procurement Platforms (APUeN).

FAPPE MEETING Faster Adoption of Public eProcurement in Europe (FAPPE) is a European network of specialists in e-enabling and e-negotiations in the public procurement sector, whose creation was initiated by RUI PATRICIO who still heads it. The network is known for pushing for an increased rate of e-enabling in PP. The meeting prepared for eBF is an opportunity to discuss the effects of changes in EU directives on public procurement and to discuss ways to accelerate its acceptance amongst contracting authorities. Another aim of the meeting is to share experience and acquire partners for potential projects in the field of public procurement and related matters. The meeting will be held in English.
